2019 Youth International Mission

Proposed Date: July 13-20, 2019

9-12 Months before departure

- Build a Mission Planning Team to confirm trip details, and build forward momentum and enthusiasm for trip. This team will organize budgeting, fundraising, and other details for trip.
- Develop a budget
- Begin fundraising projects if needed.
- Official Sign Up goes live with required \$100 deposit

6-9 Months before departure

• Recruit and finalize team roster, obtaining a commitment from each person by requiring an additional \$500 deposit by December 31.

3-6 Months before departure

- January 2019 Find travel agent, purchase plane tickets.
- Hold planning and informational meeting with team of participants (and their parents)
- Begin making travel arrangements: passports, vaccinations, etc. All passports must be dated to
 expire no less than at least 6 months before the date of travel. If a team member is not a US
 citizen, additional ID may be required.
- If applicable, collect supply items that will be distributed on the trip (eg, school supplies, hygience items, etc.)
- Each team member fill out medical release form and a release of claim form found on website.
- Hold a *Sponsor-Letter writing event*. All team members write letters to get sponsors to help pray for and financially contribute to the team. (This is a fundraiser, money goes to the general pool for the trip).
- Host large fund-raiser event.

4-6 Weeks before departure

- Discuss specific projects and finalize team itinerary.
- Finish gathering all medications and med supplies. All medications must have six months left on the expiration from the date you arrive in Nicaragua.
- If bringing a medical team, all medical documentation must be received no later than 5 weeks prior to your arrival.

General Trip Itinerary (If going to Nicaragua): Saturday, July 13 - Saturday, July 20, 2019

- Saturday, July 13: Flight to Augusto C. Sandino International Airport in Managua.
- **Sunday, July 14:** Attend/serve a local church, minister to children at El Ayudante's HCN (Nicaraguan Christian Home), and preparing for week's activities.
- **Monday, July 15 Thursday, July 18:** 8:00am 5:00pm Ministry. Evenings spent rest, and group worship/reflection.
- Friday, July 19: Tour Nicaragua after breakfast: Masaya Volcano National Park, Managua zip-line over volcano lagoon, local shopping at Masaya or Managua. Spend the night at Camino Real hotel.
- Saturday, July 20: Flight home.

- College-aged students who are/were active in Highland Youth Ministries are welcome to participate.
- Must have at least one male and one female post-college aged adult. At least one adult member of the Mission Planning Team should attend the trip.
- All adults (including college-aged students) must have completed Safe Sanctuaries training.
- Must attend all required team meetings and fundraisers
